Subjects covered will include the proper height to mow, how and when to fertilize, how to water most efficiently and much more. These techniques will give you a healthy lawn, save money and help prevent water pollution. Two 60-gallon rain barrels will be given away at end of the turf session. - **Do-It-Yourself Sprinkler Repairs**
